Committee Reports:

- Architectural Control Committee:
 - 1. Two homes remain under construction; one lot remains
- Covenant Enforcement Committee:
 - 1. One homeowner has been sent to collections for non-payment of fines
- Irrigation Committee:
 - 1. The Board will begin leaving courtesy notes on homeowner's doors kindly notifying them of the time and date of watering outside their designated time allotment in hopes of improving communication.

New Business

- A homeowner proposed creating an Echo Canyon Little Free Library. Homeowners attending were in favor of the library. Construction and placement of the library will be finalized at the April Board meeting.
- Currently, Echo Canyon has been using Classic Lawns for our mowing and irrigation repairs, and Liquid
 Green is used for weed and feed maintenance in the park, walkways, and playground area. The Board will
 solicit bids for landscape maintenance and weed and feed companies in the spring to ensure we receive
 the best quality at a reasonable cost.
