ARTICLE | NAME

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to hold ownership and to maintain roads, streets and other items or interests owned by, or existing for the joint use or benefit of, lot owners of Ouray River Park Townhomes Subdivision, Ouray County, Colorado, and to manage the same in accordance with the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall be non-stock, and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be paid to the members thereof. Each lot owner of Ouray River Park Townhomes Subdivision shall be entitled to one membership in this corporation for each lot owned. Membership in this corporation shall be appurtenant to the above mentioned lots and not personal to the lot owners.

ARTICLE VIII NEGATION OF PECUNIARY GAIN

In the event of the dissolution of this corporaton, or in the event it shall cease to carry out the objects and purposes herein set forth, all the business, property, and assets of the corporation shall go and be distributed to such nonprofit charitable corporation, municipal corporation, or corporations, as may be selected by the board of directors of this corporation so that the business properties and assets of this corporation shall then be used for, and devoted to, the purposes of carrying on a nonprofit charitable home for the aged. In no way shall any of the assets or property of this corporation, or the proceeds of any of the assets or property, in the event of dissolution, go or be distributed to members, either for the reimbursement of any sums subscribed, donated, or contributed by such members, or for any other such purpose, it being the intent in the event of the dissolution of this corporation, or upon its ceasing to carry out the object and purposes herein set forth, that the property and assets then owned by the corporation shall be transferred to the County of Ouray, Colorado.

ARTICLE X AMENDMENTS

These articles may be amended in the manner provided by the statutes of the State of Colorado at the time of amendment.

TO ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF OURAY RIVER PARK TOWNHOMES ASSOCIATION

Dated April 18, 1983

A. Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of Ouray River Park Townhomes Association is changed to read as follows:

"PURPOSE"

'The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

1. To govern the real and personal property situate in the County of Ouray, State of Colorado, known as Ouray River Park Townhomes, as described more fully in that certain Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions for Ouray River Park Townhomes recorded April 18, 1983, in the Ouray County, Colorado, Public Records.

2. To take and hold by purchase, gift, bequest, devise, lease, or assignments, either absolutely or in trust for any of its purposes, any property, real, personal or mixed, without limitation as to the amount or value thereof, and, while the owner thereof, to exercise and enjoy all of the rights, powers and privileges of ownership to the same extent as a natural person might or could; to operate, use, manage, improve, mortgage, pledge, lease, assign, sell, transfer, convey or otherwise dispose of any such property, real, personal or mixed; to invest and reinvest its funds, either principal or income, in any securities or property of whatsoever character deemed proper by its directors for such investment; and, generally to employ, donate and expend the property and funds of the corporation for the purposes contained in this paragraph and those other and further purposes stated more fully in the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Ouray River Park Townhomes.

3. To make, enter into and perform contracts of every kind and description, necessary, advisable or expedient in carrying out the purposes of the corporation, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, body politic, district, county, state or other governmental unit.

4. To act as trustee or attorney-in-fact for Unit Owners whenever so designated or authorized to do so by such Owners, without termination due to death or disability of such Owner.

5. To have one or more offices and to conduct and carry on any of its business at any place either within or without the State of Colorado, as may be determined by its Board of Directors.

6. In addition to the above, to do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of the purposes herein, and to do all other things incidental thereto, or connected therewith, which are not forbidden by the Colorado Corporation Code, by any other law, or by these Articles of Incorporation or the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of Ouray River Park Townhomes and to do so in any state, territory, district, possession, dependency, or other political subdivision of the United States of America, or in any foreign country, to the extent that such purposes are not forbidden by such subdivision of the United States or such foreign country."

B. Article V of said Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended to read as follows:

"MEMBERSHIP"

"Membership in the corporation shall be automatically awarded to each Owner, as such term is defined in the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Ouray River Park Townhomes, and voting of said members shall be regulated as provided for in said Declaration and the Bylaws."
